1. The leadership positions may have been as the leader of an organization, committee, or project.
2. Exclude service or leadership for which the candidate received payment.
3. Exclude service or leadership that resulted in contributions of a religious or political nature.
4. Typical organizations to cite are those designed to serve others in RB, enhance the quality of life in RB, improve health or education in RB, or foster the civic or cultural life of RB. The focus of your nomination should be the significant contributions to RB that resulted from the nominee's outstanding volunteer service and leadership.
