Each year, the Rancho Bernardo Hall of Fame honors outstanding volunteer leaders who have made significant contributions to Rancho Bernardo. This year, the Hall of Fame has selected Craig Brown and Jim Denton.

Craig Brown is a founding member and President of the Rancho Bernardo Business Association, which promotes quality of life in Rancho Bernardo and provides residents with free consultations on home maintenance, law, health, taxes, real estate, and other issues. As a member of the Board of Directors of the Poway Center for Performing Arts Foundation, he has played a key role in fundraising and in providing local students with opportunities to attend workshops with professional performers. As a member of the Board of Directors of the Rancho Bernardo Community Foundation, he brought worthy organizations to the attention of the Foundation and helped to establish the Rancho Bernardo Historical Society Museum.

Jim Denton served on the Rancho Bernardo Planning Board for six years, serving as its Chairman and Treasurer. He and the Board played a key role in advising the City of San Diego on land use issues and advised on development projects, conditional use and neighborhood use permits, and regional issues including water, transit and transportation. Jim has also served as Architecture Chairman of his Homeowners Association and President of the Bernardo Heights Country Club Board of Directors.

Candidates for the Rancho Bernardo Hall of Fame were nominated by the community at large in late 2008. The selection committee was made up of Hall of Fame members and leaders of other community organizations.

The new members will be honored at a luncheon to be held Saturday, March 21, 2009, at 11:30 am at the Bernardo Heights Country Club. All community members are welcome.
